- + As and when appropriate, I will commit to facilitating or providing evidenced-based wellness care consistent with the core principles of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010..., or to encouraging my clients to seek health care practitioners who are so committed;
- + As an attorney, I will abide by my State's safekeeping property rule as it relates to my clients and third-persons with an interest in any funds that I may receive.
- + As a health care practitioner, in the event that I utilize assignments and liens, I will do so primarily for the purposes of ensuring fairness and communication in the handling of funds.
- + I will commit to making my fees consistent with what is usual, customary, and reasonable in my area commensurate with my particular skills and expertise.
